



Craft Night: Quilting

Quilting Project 1: The first project is an 18"x18" wall hanging called "the color pinwheel."

Each student will need to bring the following items. These can be purchased at any craft/ fabric/ quilting store (ie Hancock Fabrics, Walmart, etc.) This project will teach you the basics of hand quilting, and is self-paced.

Fabric: Fabric must be 100% cotton. All fabrics must be washed and ironed before class. You will need $\frac{1}{4}$ of a yard of each of the following:

Off-white
Red
Orange
Yellow
Green

Blue-green
Blue
Purple
Lavender
Black

Backing Fabric: Backing fabric must also be 100% cotton. You will need $\frac{2}{3}$ of a yard of the color of your choice.

Scissors: one pair for cutting paper and one pair to cut fabric

Thread: medium to light gray in color

Needles: size 9 or 10 sharps

Straight pins

Ruler: clear (i.e. see-through) 12 inch ruler (preferably OmniGrid)

#2 pencil

white fabric marking pencil

Needle-threader: optional

Thimble: optional
