Report for first 6 months of 1932.

Classes offered by the Foundation:

for children - 136 classes (3 subjects), attendance 3,226

for adults - 184 classes (4 subjects), attendance 4,403

Classes sponsored for CCRelig Ed. - 144 classes, attendance 4,302

Total classes offered at Foundation - 328 classes, attendance 8,705.

3 exhibitions held in the Residence, attendance 584.

35 meetings held in the Residence (10 societies) - attend. 571.

Total attendance in the Residence, Jan 1 - June 30, 1932 - 9,860.

Total attendance at Museum - 5,178.

Grand Total attendance, 15,038.

Poor Richard Art & Craft Guild Exhibit May 5th & 6th, 221 projects entered.

Some details: Children's classes were in Drawing (60 classes, attend. 1,673), Soap Sculpture (38 classes, attend. 804), and Sewing (38 classes attend. 749). Adults classes were all under the Leadership Training Course, and consisted of 4 courses of 12 classes each, attendance about 100 each for ^①Primary Child and ^②Junior Child; 383 attended ^③Dramatization in Religion; and 438 attended ^④Teaching Work of the Church. Of the Meetings held in Residence, which numbered 35 altogether, of 10 groups the most numerous attended were the W.F. Pres. Society, 5 meetings, attend. 216; C C Relig. Educ., 5 meeting, attend. 106; Tuesday Club, 9 meetings, attend. 75 (viz., average 8 per meeting); W.F. N. Ky. Churches, 3 meetings, attend. 57; and Ky. Audubon Society, 4 meetings, attendance 48 (average 12 each).
