

Took up idea of assisting the Community Council of Relig Ed June 17, 1931. On July 9th they had consulted with the CCRE and offered to build a classroom for use of public school children, and to pay the salary of Miss Attig, the Principal. Also invited the Council to hold its meetings there. Miss Attig on Aug 25 or before recommended 2 courses of 12 sessions each for those desirous of completing their Teacher Training Work, formerly done under the auspices of some of the churches, & this was approved.

Leadership Training Classes for adults opened Jan 11, 1932. Appropriated \$2,150 for CCRE for 1932-33.

First half of 1932, held 144 classes sponsored by CCRE, attend 4,302. The Leadership Training Course in first half of 1932 consisted of 4 courses of 12 classes each, attendance about 100 each for Primary Child & Junior Child, and 383 for Dramatization in Religion and 438 for Teaching Work of the Church (i.e., about 35 per session).

1932, Oct 14th. Directors Meeting. Program Committee reports, support the work of Religious Education in connection with the Public Schools and holding of certain classes at the Foundation. Approved.

Note, in first $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1932 they paid \$1505 salary for CCRE.

Also in 1931 they paid \$645 salary for CCRE; and in 1932, \$2371.44.

Annual Report for 1932 under CCRE ; also some under Led Tr Classes, 2 of the 4 sessions were as above, connected with religion & church. That was adults. For children, Relig Ed., there were 1 Thurs & 2 Fri classes for children in 1932, average attend 27, 28, and 17. Total of 9 such classes held during the year.

1933. Miss Attig and her staff will again have the pupils of the First District school here for their classes in Relig Educ.
