Craft Shop is mentioned Oct 9, 1930.

1931, June 17th. Museum Reported that 91 objects were made in the Craft Shop to date.

1931, Oct 14th, Craft Shop again mentioned. Raymond S Williams was added to staff as of Oct 1, 1931. \$50 a month. As assistant to Archie Williams in the Museum.

1932, Feb 10th. Craft Shop mentioned again.

The Director of the Museum presented his report of attendance and activities of the Museum and Craft Shop from Oct 1930 to December 31, 1931.

Foundation's classes for children began Feb 6, 1932 with following enrollment:

Drawing and Painting - 150
Doll Dressmaking - 70
Soap Sculpture - 80
Total, 300.

1932, before July 14th, got 70 woodcarving tools, gift from Mr Dr George Nerish of Cincinnati.

First 6 months of 1932, attendance total

Museum: Craft Shop -- 727
Residence: Drawing -- 1673
Soap Sculpt -- 804
Sewing -- 749.

Poor Richard Art & Craft Guild Exhibit, May 5 & 6 1932 --

221 projects entered.

By fall of 1932 Craft Shop appears as an old, flourishing, and well established feature on the landscape.

1933 - Drawing & Sewing classes were the chief ones. In Craft Shop there were 4 classes. Enrolled 52. 36 classes were held with total attendance of 394 or about 11 per class.
