All Music Summary - 1

Minute June 10, 1931. On motion of Messrs Simmons, Coughlen, Rowe and Warrington ten season tickets for the symphony concerts 1931-2 were purchased to be used later as prizes or awards in accordance with a plan to be determined later.

1931, 1932. Items about the old Piano, also a second one.

Feb 10, 1932. Nothing yet about choral classes.

1932, April 13. There was some discussion regarding the suggestion that the Baker Hunt Foundation give some financial support to The Mendelssohn Singing Society. On the suggestion of Mr Rowe the question of helping to support this organization or of starting some form of musical activity by the Foundation as a part of its own program was left for further consideration and report....

1932, July 14. A request was received from the Stephen Foster Club of Covington for the use of the Foundation's auditorium as a meeting place, and for financial support for their work. On motion of Mr Rowe, duly seconded and carried, the club was invited to hold its meetings at The Baker Hunt Foundation, but the matter of financial assistance was taken under advisement to be considered in connection with the program to be outlined by the Program Committee.

Jan 1 - June 30, 1932. Disbursements: Music - Extramural - nothing in first quarter; \$150 in second quarter; \$150 total for first half

1931, Oct. 14th. On motion of M Coughlen duly seconded and carried the Executive Secretary was instructed to purchase ten good seats for the 1931-1932 series of Young People's Concerts to be given by the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra. These tickets to be distributed among music students as is being done with the tickets for the symphony concerts.
