

Rome, Wednesday, Aug. 31<sup>st</sup>

Took carriage from the Continental Hotel at ten, A.M. Visited first the remains of the Baths of Diocletian, immense space, that formerly occupied all the ground where the depot now stands.

3<sup>rd</sup> " Fontani of Felicia, Statue of Moses, the artist tried to excel Michael Angelo's Moses. And with out a model, cut the figure from stone, when it was raised, the proportions were poor. The mark too much for the height. The artist killed himself.

3<sup>rd</sup> " Cappuccini Convent - Saw all

the bones, of the departed Brothers.

4 Pincian Hills, Drive through the Park. Looked over the City from the walls. Wonderful plants, and "water clock."

5 Piazza del Popolo - Monolith in Centre from the Palace of the Sun - Necropolis - Two handsome Fountains, one to Mars - the other Neptune, Beginning of the " Corso" - Two Churches just alike, one on either side of the street. Just below stands the Church of the people, built by the peoples money, on the spot where Ghosts appeared.

6 Column of Aurelian, marks the centre of Rome - The Column
