- 2nd - William Thomas Scudder of Oakland, Cal. - One Hundred Dollars;
- 3rd - Randall Scudder of Oakland, Cal. - One Hundred Dollars.

Five Hundred Dollars to be used for a Tablet in Trinity Church, Covington, Kentucky (Madison Ave. between Third and Fourth Sts.)
(The inscription to be given at the end. This Tablet in memory of my mother, Mrs. Annie Potter Scudder)

One Hundred Dollars to be given Mr. Charles Smith, who lives at 620 Greenup Street.

After all my debts are paid the residue of my possessions goes to my Aunt,

Mrs. Margaretta W. Hunt,
of 620 Greenup St.,
Covington, Kentucky.

I, Kate Scudder, would like to add, as a note, that I wish my few belongings to remain at 620 Greenup St. except:

- Two portraits of my father and mother, painted by Eaton in 1847, the year of my parents' marriage;
- One tall looking glass, and six chairs, all that is left of my father's home;
- Two bisque figures;
- One transparent night lamp shade (called Margaret) which was used when I was born, May 28, 1849, Cincinnati, Ohio;
- One toilet set - two bottles, one caraffe and tumbler, one shaving and one powder holder - of Bohemian glass.

There are three very old silver table spoons (Mary Bailey, a great aunt) and some two or three spoons, a small picture in a deep frame, of a morning glory and a rice paper butterfly. This was a gift to my grandmother from her husband, William Woodburn Potter, when my mother, Annie Potter, was born, Nov. 10, 1824, in Philadelphia, Pa. This is my greatest treasure. These articles I want to go to William T. and Randall Scudder, of Oakland, California (my nephews).
