## Teacher Dead

### Funeral Services Monday for Mrs. Kate E. Culbertson.

Services will be held Monday for Mrs. Kate E. Culbertson, 82, retired art teacher in the Covington public schools, who died Friday night at her home, 501 Garrard street, Covington. Mrs. Culbertson succumbed after a two weeks' illness of pneumonia. She taught in the Covington schools for 28 years and was a charter member of the Covington Art Club and one of the oldest members of the Cincinnati Art Academy, having joined one week after its organization. She was also one of the oldest living members of the Madison Avenue Christian Church, Covington.

Mrs. Culbertson was born in Stanford, Ky., and became a resident of Kenton County in 1880. Her husband, Louie E. Culbertson, died in 1896 and she became an art teacher in the Covington school system. She was retired in 1924.

Surviving her are two daughters, Mrs. T. J. Donovan, Garrard street, Covington, and Mrs. Orie S. Ware, wife of former Congressman Orie S. Ware, with whom she made her home; four grandchildren, Mrs. Joseph Wile, Lexington; Carroll Miller, William and James Ware, Covington, and two great grandchildren.
