The Kentucky Historical Marker Program is administered by the Kentucky Historical Society in cooperation with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. The program was started in 1949 to provide individuals and organizations the opportunity to commemorate historic sites, events, and personalities throughout Kentucky. Today there are over 2,300 markers throughout Kentucky. Applications are reviewed by an advisory committee that meets twice a year.
