Play a video related to the ebook. A closed-captioning option is available.



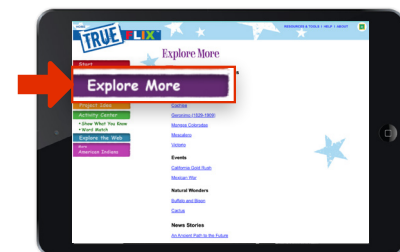
Read the eBook

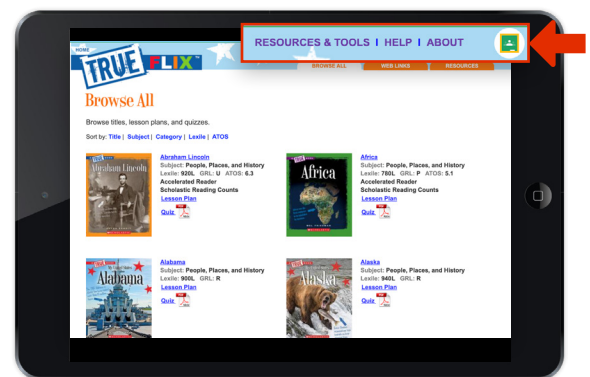
